How will the improvements be funded?

Funding for the implementation of the improvements will come from federal, state, and local sources.

When can I expect to see improvements start to be implemented?

This will depend on what concepts are proposed to move towards implementation. The FDOT will develop a plan which may include some short-term and long-term improvements. The timeline will differ for each project.

Is right-of-way needed to construct these improvements?

Minimal right-of-way may be required for the implementation of some of the improvements. However, the amount of right-of-way needed has been minimized in the interest of reducing impacts to the surrounding areas. Right-of-way impacts will be further evaluated in design.
