1 Joe Gillo, 1300 Winchester Road North, St. Petersburg,

4 My name is Joe Gillo. I reside at 1300
5 Winchester Road North, St. Petersburg, Florida 33710.
6 Telephone number is (727) 381-4871. I'm at this meeting
7 of the DOT in reference to the DOT project at U.S. 19 and
8 118th Avenue. My concerns are with the cemetery on the
9 northeast corner of 118th Avenue and U.S. 19. Over the
10 past 35 years, U.S. 19 has been worked on and widened and
11 widened some more and right of way bought and used. Now
12 according to this project, the last bit of right of way
13 that the state owns is going to be used for projects and
14 making a U.S. 19 overpass and also the fly-over.
15 Unfortunately, we own a cemetery plot with people buried
16 in it in front of that cemetery. At that point when we
17 bought this cemetery lot, there was loads of property out
18 there. And over the years, it has dwindled, dwindled and
19 dwindled. Now according to your project, when the final
20 project is done and the frontage road is built, we will be
21 within -- I don't know exact footage. I don't want to
22 really say. But it's very close to the side of the road,
23 and you will have no more frontage left. I am expressing
24 my concerns because I would like to know who will do
25 something about this or be in contact with me to find out

1 what we can do about it, because we have had many problems
2 over the last ten years now because of people coming in
3 and out of there and doing different things. I talk to
4 the cemetery. They tell me to talk to you. I talk to you
5 now at this meeting, and they tell me to talk to the
6 cemetery. So, I don't know what we're going to do about
7 this, but we need to figure out something. Thank you.

9 MR. CLIFFORD: Good evening. My name is Bob
10 Clifford, and I am the Modal Planning and Development
11 Manager for District Seven of the Florida Department of
12 Transportation. Welcome to the Public Hearing for the
13 118th Avenue (County Road 296) Connector Project
14 Development and Environment Study. This public hearing
15 concerns the proposed improvements on 118th Avenue from
16 U.S. 19 to east of the Roosevelt/County Road 296 connector
17 in Pinellas County.

18 Today is Thursday, August 18, 2005, and it is
19 approximately 6:00 p.m. We are assembled at the Morgan
20 Fitzgerald Middle School in Largo, Florida. This is your
21 opportunity to receive information on the project and
22 officially comment on the recommended "build" alternative

24 recommended "build" alternative is based on comprehensive
25 environmental and engineering analyses completed to date,

1 as well as on public comments that have been received so
2 far.

3 This project development and environment, or
4 PD&E study, and public hearing are being conducted under
5 applicable Federal and State laws. Those citations are
6 listed on the board next to the sign-in table.

7 When you arrived this evening, you should have
8 received an information packet containing an informational
9 newsletter and a comment form. If you weren't able to
10 sign in or did not receive an information packet, please
11 stop by our sign-in table before you leave this evening.

12 You should have also had the opportunity to view
13 the audio-visual presentation that is continuously running
14 behind the stage throughout this public hearing. Those
15 who wish to provide comments during this portion of the
16 public hearing should complete a speaker's card and submit
17 it to us so we can call you up and get your comments. If
18 you did not receive a card and wish to speak, please raise
19 your hand, and we'll gladly provide you one now. Is there
20 anybody who wishes to speak that hasn't filled out a card
21 yet? Okay.

22 In addition to making oral statements, you may

3 formal comment? If not, what I would do is close this
4 portion of the hearing, which is the formal portion. It's
5 not a presentation portion of the hearing. That portion
6 is part of the video, and then in a question-and-answer
7 format with our representatives out here today.

8 The key representatives to speak to if you have
9 questions are our consultant project manager Jeff Novotny,
10 our department project manager Gabor Farkasfalvy, and also
11 our project development engineer Kirk Bogen is also here.
12 Those are three key guys to see if you have any specific
13 questions on the project.

14 With that said, what I'm going to go ahead and
15 do is close the formal portion and let everybody get back,
16 ask their questions, view the video, and we'll go from
17 there.

5 Norman Belson, Knight Shooting Sports, Inc., 12000 U.S.
6 Highway 19 North, Clearwater, Florida 33764, approached
7 the court reporter and made the following comments:

8 Good evening. Norman Belson. Norm Belson.
9 Firearms instructor at Knight Shooting Sports, 12000 U.S.
10 Highway 19 North, Clearwater, Florida 33764. After
11 reviewing the plans and speaking to some of the DOT reps,
12 it's apparent that this meeting is a complete waste of
13 time. The plans have already been made. It just depends
14 on when they're going to implement.

15 I'm particularly concerned with Knight Shooting
16 Sports. I have been affiliated with the owner and his
17 family for nine years. I've watched the process, develop
18 this building, this tremendous shooting facility for nine
19 years, and now it's going to be destroyed. It's going to
20 be isolated. All the effort, the energy, the money, the
21 sweat, equity, the time to develop a superlative super
22 business is going to be destroyed when this fly-over is
23 completed. If nothing else, it's going to become
24 virtually impossible for the public to gain access, even
25 if the building is allowed to remain in its current

1 position.

2 The site was specifically chosen by the owners
3 for access and view of those persons traveling U.S. 19.
4 That was a primary consideration, and now it's about to be
5 obliterated, to be totally removed. To build the
6 facility, it took virtually five years. And so that means
7 it's going to be five years before the plan is implemented
8 to start the process that they need to be relocated and
9 have their business re-established in its current
10 condition.

11 As far as I'm concerned, that's the
12 responsibility of DOT. They're the ones that are doing
13 the planning. They're the ones that are going to destroy
14 the facility and destroy their client base. It's a very
15 fickle environment, because people get used to shooting at
16 a specific facility. Once they start instruction, as it
17 seems in all other road construction projects in Florida,
18 a two-year or three-year project turns into four or five
19 years. And during that point in time, with the present
20 schemata, the business will be out of business once they
21 start any of the preparatory work.

22 So, I think it's ridiculous. I think the north
23 county needs it. I don't think the south county needs
24 it. I think it's a waste of time. If you're looking for
25 20 years ahead, it's not going to make any difference

1 because by the time you get this done in 20 years, it's
2 already going to be obsolete and overcome by events and
3 population explosion. So, personally, I don't think it's
4 required. I think it's idiotic and a waste of money.
5 Thank you very much.

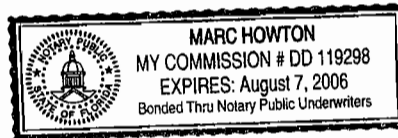
