



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PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT PLAN

Project Development and Environment Study

Fowler Avenue/State Road 582 from N. Florida Avenue to west of N. 56th Street

The purpose of this Public Involvement Plan (PIP) is to assist in providing information to and obtaining input from concerned citizens, agencies, private groups (residential/business), and governmental entities. The overall goal of this plan is to help ensure that the study reflects the values and needs of the communities it is designed to benefit. A schedule of events and a list of documentation exhibiting compliance with these procedures are included.

This plan is in compliance with the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) July 1, 2020, Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Manual, Part 1; Chapter 11, and Part 2; Chapter 9; the FDOT Public Involvement Handbook; Section 339.155, Florida Statutes (F.S.); Executive Orders 11990 and 11988; Council on Environmental Quality Regulations for Implementing the Procedural Provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA); and 23 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 771.

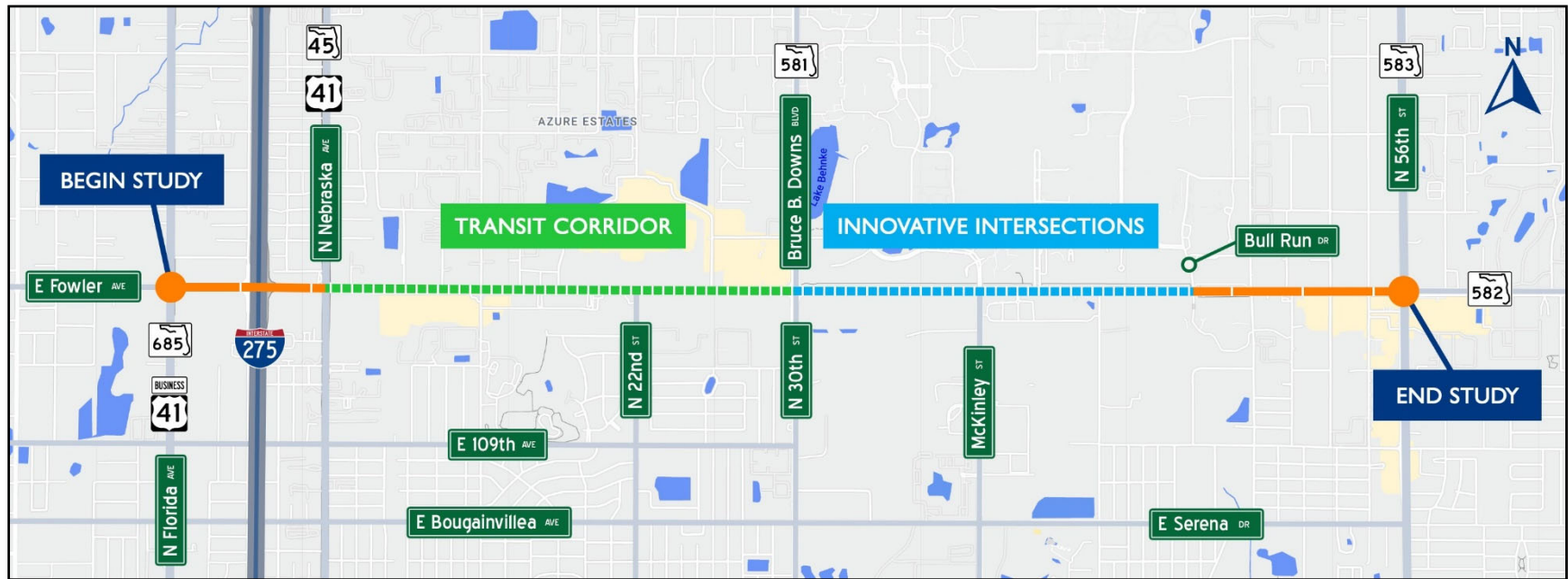

Study Limits: Fowler Avenue/State Road (SR) 582 from N. Florida Avenue to west of N. 56th Street (Refer to Figure 1)

Proposed Activity: The Fowler Avenue PD&E Study will evaluate location and design concepts for operational and transit improvements to Fowler Avenue from N. Florida Avenue to N. 56th Street in Hillsborough County, a distance of approximately 4.0 miles. Improvements associated with the study may include the transit accommodations and/or intersection improvements. Improvements may require the addition of right-of-way depending on the preferred alternative.

Class of Action: The Class of Action is to be determined.

II. Study Background

The FDOT, District 7 is conducting a PD&E Study on Fowler Avenue from N. Florida Avenue to N. 56th Street, a distance of approximately 4.0 miles. Fowler Avenue within the study area has historically been a corridor with a high vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian crash rate. The study area and immediate surrounds is home to the University of South Florida (USF), several major hospitals, a theme park, a commercial shopping district and residential neighborhoods. The PD&E Study being conducted for the study corridor is to determine the preferred alternative to provide enhanced transit and safer conditions for all users.

According to 2022 FDOT Efficient Transportation Decision Making (ETDM), Environmental Screening Tool (EST) study area demographics, a concentration of non-English speaking Asian residents resides north of Fowler Avenue east of N 56th Street as well as south of Fowler Avenue west of Bruce B. Downs Boulevard. Non-English speaking Hispanic concentrations were also identified throughout the corridor north and south of Fowler Avenue, but predominantly west of Bruce B. Downs Boulevard. Both ethnicities have large populations throughout the corridor. This area is also home to a large number of households with no vehicles. Addressing the mobility needs of all populations within this extremely diverse study area is a priority of the FDOT, the cities of Tampa and Temple Terrace, and Hillsborough County.

The study has not yet been screened through the Programming Screen of FDOT's ETDM process. The FDOT's EST, Area of Interest Mapper was utilized to help identify the make-up of the study area neighborhoods to complete this plan.

III. Study Goals

The following goals and objectives have been defined for the PD&E Study:

1. Analyze transit corridor alternatives, multimodal improvements, roadway configuration, innovative intersections, and bicycle and pedestrian improvements along Fowler Avenue from N. Florida Avenue to N. 56th Street.

The three transit alternatives to be analyzed include:

- Business Access and Transit (BAT) Lane Concept
- Frontage Road Concept
- Median Transitway Concept

All will convert a general purpose/continuous right-turn lane into a transit prioritized/exclusive lane to accommodate transit service from Nebraska Avenue/SR 45 to the Bruce B. Downs Boulevard/County Road (CR) 581/30th Street intersection.

Innovative intersections are to be analyzed from Bruce B. Downs Boulevard/30th Street to Bull Run Drive.

2. Determine the factors related to the design and location of the facility including alternative alignments, transportation needs, social impacts, economic factors, and environmental effects.
3. Develop cost estimates for each alternative.
4. Evaluate alternatives and recommend a preferred alternative.

The purpose of the Fowler Avenue Multimodal PD&E Study is to provide increased transit and mobility opportunities and improve safety within the study corridor to meet future transportation demand in this rapidly evolving area of Tampa, Temple Terrace and Hillsborough County.

Figure 2. Study Area Jurisdictional Boundary Map

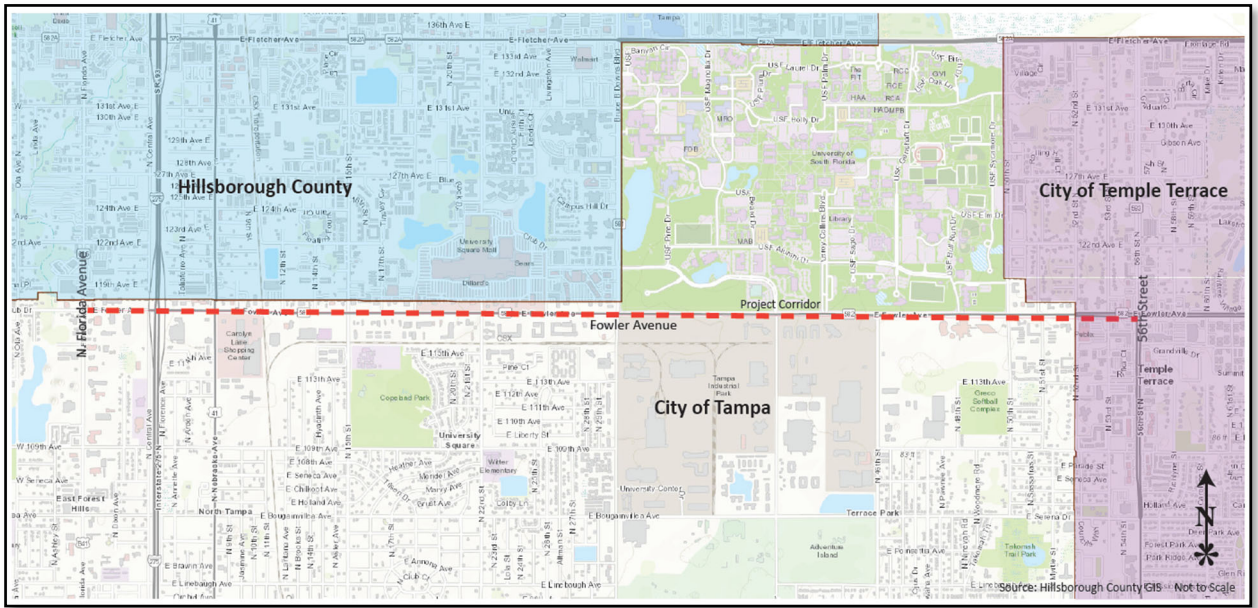
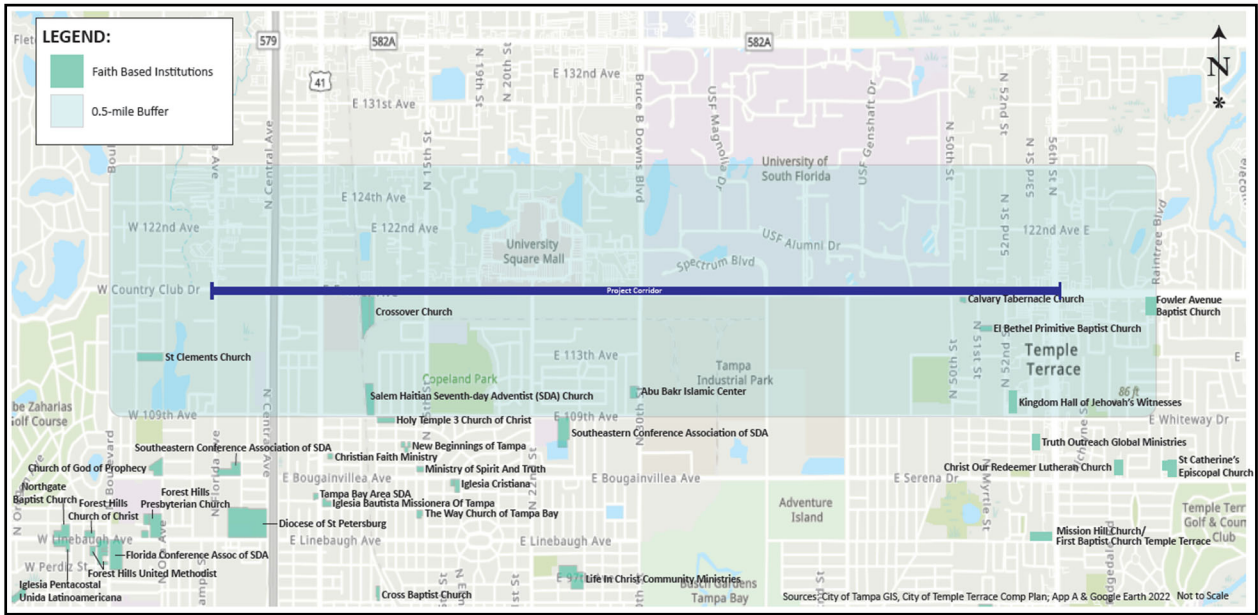


Figure 3. Churches in the Study Area

In addition to working with the media, a number of different notification techniques will be used throughout the study development process. A brief description of these techniques is listed below.

Letters/Newsletters:	Invitational and informational newsletters will be distributed to elected and appointed officials, property owners/tenants, business owners/operators, and interested parties as feasible. It is anticipated that up to four newsletters may be distributed for this study: kick-off, at key points during the study, Alternatives Public Workshop/Public Hearing, and approval of study.
News/Press Releases:	News/press releases will be submitted to the FDOT five days prior to a public meeting or public hearing.
Public Notices/Ads:	Public advertisement will be published in the area newspaper with the largest circulation (Tampa Bay Times) as well as the local Hispanic newspaper prior to the Alternatives Public Workshop or Public Hearing, and to announce Location and Design Concept Acceptance (LDCA) at the end of the study. Newspaper ads will be published one-time 10-14 days prior to the meeting. Should a Public Hearing be held the first newspaper ad will be published 15-30 days prior, and a second ad 7-15 days prior.
Public Announcements:	In order to distribute PD&E phase information, the newsletter or a flier will be made available to organizations such as neighborhood/civic groups, the City of Tampa, the City of Temple Terrace and Hillsborough County to publish in existing newsletters and websites. Any such correspondence will be coordinated through the District's Public Information Office (PIO).

Techniques:	Presentations to Local Officials: Presentations will be given to local officials and key agencies such as the Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) prior to the Alternatives Public Workshop to apprise local officials of the

study status, specific location, and design concepts, and to receive their comments.

Alternatives Public Workshop: One Alternatives Public Workshop is anticipated to be held to present the study and the conceptual study alternatives being considered, and to obtain comments from the general public. This meeting will be informal.

Public Hearing (if necessary): A formal Public Hearing, as required by federal regulations and state law may be required.

Informal Meetings: In addition to the scheduled public meetings, the FDOT will attend meetings anticipated to be held with the general public, elected and appointed officials, public agencies, and civic groups. The purpose of these small group meetings will be to apprise the attendees of the study status, specific location, and design concepts, and to receive input.

Website: The study will be included on FDOT's project information website. The website will incorporate graphics and narratives providing study information. The website will be updated on an as needed basis at key milestones. Study newsletters and other written materials will refer readers to this site. VII. Coordination with City of Tampa, the City of Temple Terrace & Hillsborough County

Coordination with the Cities of Tampa, Temple Terrace and Hillsborough County will occur throughout the study. Copies of aerial maps depicting all alignment and design concepts under consideration, along with draft copies of engineering and environmental study documentation, will be furnished to the City and County Engineers, with their review and written comments solicited.

VIII. Hybrid Alternatives Public Workshop and/or Public Hearing

In compliance with the PD&E Manual, 23 CFR 771, and Section 339.155, F.S., a formal hybrid public hearing may be required.

An informal hybrid Alternative PIM will be held with the following stipulations.

Public Meeting Site: The Alternatives Public Workshop and/or Public Hearing will be held at an appropriate facility located within or within close proximity to the study area that is ADA compliant and accessible by transit. Available options include the Ip Tampa facility or LOOK Dine-in Cinema at University Mall, Embassy Suites Tampa USF, Copeland Park Community Center, and MOSI.

The hybrid (virtual) component of the meeting will be through GoToWebinar. Registration in advance will be required for those wishing to attend virtually. All information available at the in-person meeting will be available to the virtual attendees via the study website. Questions can be asked of the FDOT virtual staff via the GoToWebinar chat area.

Public Advertisement: Display ads will appear in the Tampa Bay Times, the Florida Sentinel Bulletin, and the La Gaceta newspapers twice prior to the Alternatives Public Workshop/Public Hearing. See contact information above in Section VI. Outreach Activities.

All advertisements to local newspapers will be sent via email or by registered mail (returned receipt requested).

Public Hearing - An announcement of the Alternatives Public Workshop and/or Public Hearing will be published in the Florida Administrative Register (FAR) at least seven (7) days prior to the public hearing. See Section 11.2.5.4.4 for instructions regarding FAR Ad submittal.

Letters of Invitation: A newsletter will be mailed to all property owners inviting them to the Alternatives Public Workshop/Public Hearing (if necessary) as required by Section 339.155, F.S., and to local elected and appointed government officials.

Preparation: Slide presentations and/or video presentations, study corridor aerial maps, graphics, and handouts will be prepared to supplement the Alternatives Public Workshop and/or Public Hearing (if necessary).
