PROJECT LOCATION






WPI 443770-1: from I-4 to north of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard (SR 574)














Tonight's graphics illustrate potential locations for, and the extent of, noise barriers




during the design phase when more detailed roadway data are available




