1.0 INTRODUCTION

A Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study was conducted for the Pasco County Engineering Services Department in cooperation with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to evaluate proposed improvements to State Road 52 (SR 52).

The proposed improvements include the widening of SR 52 from east of the Interstate-75 ramps to east of Emmaus Cemetery Road from a two-lane roadway to a six-lane divided roadway, a distance of approximately 1.9 miles.

The project is consistent with the State of Florida's Department of Community Affairs approved local government comprehensive plan required under Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.

This Public Involvement Comments and Coordination Report summarizes the public involvement effort. The Public Hearing was held on April 21, 2005.

2.0 ADVANCED NOTIFICATION

An Advanced Notification (AN) Package was sent to the Florida State Clearinghouse on October 1, 2004. The package contained a description of the project, the mailing list, a project fact sheet and a project location map.

2.1 Responses

There were two responses received. The first was from the Seminole Nation of Oklahoma, stating that there is a high probability that cultural resources and materials may be encountered, that they are not currently aware of any such resources, and that if any resources are encountered, they must be immediately notified. The second response was from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, stating that the project is consistent with the Florida Coastal Management Program.

2.2 No Comment

The following agencies responded that they had no comment: Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Southwest Florida Water Management District, Office of Policy and Budget, Environmental Policy Unit.

3.0 PUBLIC HEARING

The Public Hearing was held on Thursday, April 21st, 2005, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Pasco County Historic Courthouse located at 37918 Meridian Avenue in Dade City.

3.1 PREPARATION

3.1.1 Notification letter and Mailing List

A mailing list was compiled which included all property owners within 300-feet of the proposed project, elected and appointed officials. A letter dated March 22, 2005 was sent inviting these parties to the Public Hearing.

3.1.2 Newspaper Advertisement

The legal notice advertising the Public Hearing and providing information on locations for review of the study and reports was published on 03/22/05 and 04/14/05 in the Tampa Tribune, Pasco Edition. The Florida Administrative Weekly (FAW) notice was published 03/25/2005, Volume 31/12.

3.1.3 Hearing Handout

A project handout which included information on the project and the recommended alignment along with a project location map were provided at the Public Hearing.

3.1.4 Display Graphics

Two large display boards (1"=100' scale) depicting the preferred alignment over an aerial photograph including the 4-lane interim and 6-lane ultimate typical sections were presented at the hearing. A reduced scale copy of the display is attached.

3.2 FOLLOW-UP

3.2.1 Comments Received

There were no formal comments provided during the Public Hearing.

After the Public Hearing; eight comment forms, one letter, and five e-mails were received by the project representative at Wilson Miller. The majority of the comments were concerns about the proposed access. A letter from a representative of the E/G Family Enterprise parcel stated that the proposed directional median opening in front of their property will not adequately service the existing business, which includes truck and semi tractor trailer traffic. The remaining correspondence (comment forms and e-mails) concerned access to the San Antonio Community Church. The current design approved by the FDOT access management committee does not include a median opening at the entrance to the church.

3.2.2 Responses to Comments

The phone call from a representative of an adjacent owner regarding access to E/G Family Enterprises was returned by the project design engineer. Project representatives are coordinating with FDOT access management staff to address the concern. None of the additional comments required any further action.

The attached Advance Notification Package is forwarded to your office for processing through appropriate State agencies in accordance with Executive Order 95-359. Distribution to local and Federal agencies is being made as noted.

Although more specific comments will be solicited during the permit coordination process, we request that permitting and permit reviewing agencies review the attached information and furnish us with whatever general comments they consider pertinent at this time.

Please be aware, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the Pasco County MPO has initiated the Efficient Transportation Decision Making (ETDM) process for State Road 52 from Interstate-75 to Curley Road, a 3.205 mile segment (ETDM # 3105). The segment incorporated in this SEIR notification is the westerly 1.89 miles of the overall ETDM segment. The ETAT review has been completed for the planning screen and agencies comments have been received, see attached list of ETAT Contacts.

This is a non-Federal aid action and the FDOT in conjunction with Pasco County will determine what degree of environmental documentation will be necessary. determination will be based upon in-house environmental evaluations and comments received through coordination with other agencies. are involved, we request a consistency review be performed due to possibility of acquiring permits from federal agencies.

- 1. Need for Project: The Developer of the Cannon Ranch DRI in Central Pasco County, Florida is required to widen the existing 2-lane SR 52 to a 4-lane section as mitigation for the transportation impacts of the development. The need for the project was determined during the local, regional and state review of the transportation analysis of the project. Further, the project has been identified on the 2025 Long range Transportation Plan for Pasco County (November 2001).
- 2. Description of the Project: The limits of the proposed widening cover an approximately 2-mile length from 750-feet west of the interchange of Interstate-75 and State Road 52 eastward to 1775 feet east of the proposed entrance of the Cannon Ranch development. The project will result in the widening of this section of State Road 52 from a 2-lane undivided roadway to a 4-lane divided roadway.

3. Environmental Information:

- a. Land Uses: The project area is primarily unimproved or in pastureland use. There are also commercial uses along the westerly portion of the project area, residential and community facilities (churches) along the north side of SR 52 on the eastern end of the project area.
- b. Wetlands: Isolated wetlands will be impacted. A total of 1.52 acres of impact are anticipated. There will be one wetland crossing at Cross Bayou. Mitigation will be provided during permitting.
- c. Floodplains: The project corridor is located in Zone "D"- an area of minimal flooding- as indicated on FEMA FIRM # 1202300275D (Located outside of special floodway hazard).
- d. Wildlife and Habitat: Minimal impacts are anticipated in the project corridor. A full survey and report is being prepared.
- e. Outstanding Florida Waters: No Outstanding Florida Waters are located within the project area
- f. Aquatic Preserves: No aquatic preserves are located within the project area.
- g. Coastal Zone Consistency Determination is Required : X Yes No
- h. Cultural Resources: A Cultural Resource Assessment Survey has been completed for the widening project and there are no prehistoric or historic structures within the area of the road widening.

The road expansion does not impact this site. Additional environmental assessment activities will be conducted prior to construction.

- l. Noise: Minimal impacts are anticipated as there is very little residential development adjacent to the project. A full report will be prepared.

Archaeological testing, construction activities, and locting can destroy, damage or otherwise diminish the integrity of Seminole cultural resources, please be advised of the following:

It is the policy of the Seminole Nanon of Oklahoma in the event of madvertent discoveries of ancestral remains or burial artifacts that all site surveys and/or other site activities cease pending immediate notification of this office and until such remains and artifacts have been properly secured. Further, we oppose any laboratory testing data remeval, non-biodegradable shrouding photographic documentation, public display, or unauthorized removal of incestral remains or burial artifacts. Sites which are known to possess or that are discovered to possess our ancestral remains or burial artifacts, or which are of historical cultural or religious significance to the Seminole Indian people should be avoided.



Dear Ms. Abernethy,

The meeting on April 21, 2005 was very informative. As per our discussion, I have concerns about the proposed medium and the traffic safety hazards it will cause, Due to the inability to turn west bound from our property at 30904 SR 52 in San Antonio. It is extremely important in terms of safety for those exiting our property, as well as those driving on SR 52, to be able to turn both directions. The current proposal does not allow for a left turn out of our property. This would force drivers to turn East bound search for an area to make a U turn in order to go West (towards I-75). As a manufacturing and storage facility, a large percentage of our traffic is from semi tractor trailers and Trucks with trailers. Having to go East in search of an area to make "U" turns from our facility would be unsafe for drivers as well as the other drivers on SR 52, and may require drivers to trespass on private property Traffic tie ups would be inevitable as well.

We have Cars, Pick up trucks, Pick up trucks with trailers to 40° Straight trucks, Tractors towing 1 and 2 trailers and Tractors with flat bed trailers with loads up to 60°. Loads of these lengths can require distances exceeding the proposed road width in order to make a "U" turn. Making a U turn would tie up traffic in East and west bound lanes. There is not a public area which a safe "U" turn could be made forcing drivers to trespass on private property in order to return West bound. A fact we are keenly aware of as drivers routinely use our property to turn around in now.

Currently our property houses 13 semi tractor trailers, 4 trucks and trailers, and personal autos for 25 employees. As business continues to grow, we anticipate increased trips in and out of the property. As land around our facility is developed, traffic on SR 52 will also invariably increase. Not having a break in the island to allow west bound turns would cause delays and unsafe conditions for drivers turning into and out of this property as well as those traveling on Highway 52.

Currently we have 8008 trips in and out of our driveway per year. Projections as of 1/1/2006 is for 11,544 trips per year. These numbers are only for traffic I can account for and does not include vehicles that use our property as a method to "U" turn.

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

Mr. George Little, an appraiser, called representing E/G Family Enterprises.

He and the E/G Family Enterprises representative reviewed the concept plans and are very concerned about the access to E/G Family Enterprises.

He stated that the inability to make left turn out will be a problem as they have semi-tractor trailers utilizing the site. Sicso has approximately 40 trucks per day, and there is a total of 90 trucks per day.



As it is drawn, there appears to be no allowance for a cut across the median which would allow vehicles access to San Antonio Community Church. The result would be that everyone who attends services will be forced to make a U-turn every time they attend, either coming or going.

Currently, there would be approximately fifty U-turns required on a Sunday morning. As the church grows to a potential attendance of several hundred — our acreage would currently allow capacity of about twelve hundred (1200) — this would become an overwhelming risk.

MS. ABERNETHY: Good evening. My name is Liz Abernethy. I'm a project manager with WilsonMiller.

I'm here tonight to present on behalf of Pasco County. Welcome to the State Road 52
Project Development and Environment Public Hearing.

The purpose of our public hearing tonight is to go over the proposed improvements to State Road 52.

The project starts just east of

Interstate 75 and extends about 1.9 miles to
the east, just past Emmaus Cemetery Road.

The proposed widening is to -- proposed improvement is to widen State Road 52 from a two-lane rural to a six-lane divided roadway with an interim four-lane improvement.

Before I continue, I'd like to recognize our public official that's here tonight.

If you wouldn't mind standing and introducing yourself?

MR. SCHRADER: I'm Commissioner Ted Schrader.
Nice to be here. Thanks for being here.

MS. ABERNETHY: For the record, today is

April 21st, 2005. We're just at 6 o'clock, and we're here at the Pasco County Historic Courthouse in Dade City.

This project development environment study and public hearing are being conducted in accordance with state and federal laws; and those citations, if you're interested, are listed on our sign-in table on the other side.

Also located on our sign-in table we have a project handout and location map and a comment form and speaker cards.

That comment form can be filled out and placed in one of the comment boxes or mailed back to my office to the address listed on the back of that form.

If you'd like to speak in front of the group tonight, I do need you to fill out a speaker card, and if you haven't received one of those and you need one, Chris will be happy to hand one to you.

If you fill out one of those comment cards and mail it back, I do need those back to my -- postmarked by May 2nd in order to become part of the official record.

And at this time I want to go ahead and

start taking public comments. Is there anybody that wanted to make a comment to the group tonight? We have a small group.

MR. SMITH: Liz, you might mention that they can also make comments to the --

MS. ABERNETHY: Right. Thank you for reminding me. If you're more comfortable, you can speak directly to our court reporter and provide comments directly to her.

MR. SUMNER: When will you anticipate having all of the approvals you need from DOT, Swiftmud, and every other governing agency to be able to start construction of that road?

MS. ABERNETHY: I can answer, but I'll let Elton. This is Elton Smith.

MR. SMITH: Good evening. My name is Elton
Smith. I'm with the consulting firm of
WilsonMiller representing the developer and
working on behalf of Pasco County and DOT in this
SEIR or PD&E process.

SEIR stands for State Environmental Impact
Report, and it's a state version of the PD&E
process that is done on federally-funded
projects.

The answer is that we would hope to have

completion of our -- all of our approvals in place late summer or early fall and start -- we could be in the bidding process after the first of the year.

The bidding process of course has to go through Pasco County procedures and regulations.

MR. SUMNER: What happens if you don't have all the riders? Are you expected to have to do it all voluntarily?

MR. SMITH: We would pass the resolution and discuss it. That would be required in order for them to acquire the properties that they couldn't obtain voluntarily.

MR. SUMNER: Other questions? I guess you're off the hook.

MS. ABERNETHY: Okay. This was a short meeting. Any more questions?

MR. WEAVER: I wonder if you could expand on that a little bit and speak to the issues of some of the property owners who have been approached about selling some of their property for this widening project.

MR. SUMNER: And you can give us your name if you want to --

MR. WEAVER: My name is Jim Fort.

MR. SUMNER: And are you a property owner

3 | or -

MR. WEAVER: No, but I represent a property owner.

MR. SUMNER: Okay. I'll come up here. Okay. My name is Bob Sumner. I'm the county attorney. The arrangement that we have is in the DRI approval of Cannon Ranch which is now Belle Verde or something like that.

The development order requires that development to do -- to acquire the right of way or pay for the right of way and construct the road from the interstate over to their property, and then there's another agreement that when we complete another phase of Clinton Avenue over to Hurley Road, then they have the obligation to connect the road through their project.

To that point in time they are four-lane to the entrance, the present entrance that they have on 52.

So naturally, they do not have the authority to condemn the property; but when the PD&E, with all of the approvals, then the Board

of County Commissioners will adopt a resolution of necessity, and we've agreed that Ben Harrill, an attorney in New Port Richey, will act on behalf of the County and the developer to acquire the property.

I believe the County has to say this project is necessary, that the parcels that are being taken are necessary for the project to either four-lane or six-lane the road.

And so that's kind of how it's going, but a portion of the road that's being acquired and built is impact-fee creditable, so they get credit on the impact fees as a part of the project.

The other part is not creditable. Of course I guess the argument about what is and is not, we'll resolve that.

But still, the part that's impact-fee creditable the County is very interested in because we want this cost to stay as low as possible because it's really costing us some money because we're having to give the credits.

The part that's not impact-fee creditable, then if we help them in acquiring the road, we would help them in acquiring the ponds and

everything else, but that's their own -that's -- they pay for that, and they're not
compensated or given credits for those
portions.

And I guess it doesn't show on the map here, but what we really consider to be impact-fee creditable is the part to the printing place there on the curb, right in that area, because everything's creditable until the edge of their property, and when you get to the edge of the property, anything else is not impact-fee creditable.

That's not really important to -- or germane to the idea of who -- they still have to pay you fair market value for the property.

They -- they're in the process of having appraisals done now on the property. I guess that's the reason I was asking -- that's the reason I asked the question as to when you plan on having all these approvals, because as you go through the process of approval you will have the situation where Swiftmud may say your pond siting is not right, your pond's not large enough, you know, the drainage isn't correct, any number of things, and then the changes have

to be made in the design and the construction plans before they get the final approval.

But that's basically the way it works, or the way I contemplate it's going to work. Any other questions for me?

MS. ABERNETHY: Thank you.

MR. SUMNER: Ron, did you want to add anything to it?

MR. WEAVER: You said it fine. If I had anything to add, I would.

MS. ABERNETHY: Is there anyone else interested in making a statement? What I'm going to do at this time is close the formal part of the hearing.

We will stay here, answer questions informally. You're welcome to provide comments to Gretchen directly or fill out those comment cards, and the public hearing transcript and all of these materials will be available for you to review at my office which is located at 15438 North Florida.

That information is on the project handout or you can see me. I'll give you a business card. That will be available within three weeks.

So it's 6:10, so I'm officially closing the formal portion of the public hearing, and I appreciate your coming out tonight. And again, we'll be here to answer more questions if you'd like to ask. Good evening. Thank you.
