



## **SECTION 1 INTRODUCTION**

### **1.1 GENERAL**

The objective of the *Utility Assessment Package (UAP)* is to provide documented utility information for the purpose of evaluating and considering potential surface and subsurface utility conflicts associated with the proposed project. The UAP is part of the PD&E study to help the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT or Department) and any federal agencies reach a decision on the type, location, and conceptual design of the necessary improvements to US 41 to safely and efficiently accommodate future travel demand.

### **1.2 UTILITY ASSESSMENT PACKAGE PROCESS**

The beginning of the UAP process is to contact Sunshine State One Call of Florida by an internet ticket entry. As a result, a utility contact list is created of participating members in the project area. Each utility owner on the above list was then contacted and asked to verify ownership or operation of any facilities, existing or proposed, within the US 41 project area. These owners (see list of utility owners in Section 2) were then provided with aerial photography based preliminary conceptual design plans. The owners were asked to mark and return one set of plans with their facilities, or a CADD file with their direct input (if available) and include any other pertinent information. The information was gathered and then referenced onto the Preliminary Conceptual Design Plans included in this report (see **Appendix B**, Preliminary Conceptual Design Plans (includes existing utilities)).

### **1.3 PURPOSE OF REPORT**

The purpose of this report is to document relevant information concerning the location, dimension and characteristics of major utilities discovered to be within the footprint of the proposed widening of US 41. All of the information provided will be used for appropriate consideration in locating the project, minimizing disruption of the surrounding community, and developing the conceptual design typical section. The PD&E Reports can use the information provided and reach whatever conclusions are appropriate based on the information provided.

## **2.2 *DISPOSITION OF EXISTING UTILITIES IN PROJECT AREA***

See **Appendix B** for Preliminary Conceptual Design Plans showing the location of existing utilities. A description of the existing facilities is summarized below:

### **2.2.1 *Bright House Networks***

Bright House Networks has indicated that 100 percent of their facilities are going to be pole transfers with one exception being at the southwest corner of Lula St and US 41, where they have a small underground portion of cable at that location. All other facilities will have to be pole transfers if TECO has plans for moving any poles.

### **2.2.2 *Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC***

Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC has a 20" steel pipeline running from the Riverview Plant guard house to the west side of US 41, then north and crossing US 41 at Riverview Drive. The existing 20" steel pipeline is out of service from the east side of US 41. A 24" HDPE pipeline is connected and then crosses the railroad tracks to the east, and then crosses Riverview Drive to the north side of Riverview Drive and continues east.

### **2.2.3 *Central Florida Pipeline / Kinder Morgan***

Kinder Morgan has a 16" liquid petroleum pipeline that crosses US 41 running east and west on the south side of Madison. Kinder Morgan requires a representative onsite for any excavation within 10 feet of its pipeline.

### **2.2.4 *Florida Gas Transmission***

Florida Gas Transmission has indicated there is an existing 6.625" o.d.x 0.312" w.t., grade B, natural gas transmission pipeline (FLBXD) that approaches from the southwest side of US 41 and crosses

US41 at Riverview Drive to the northeast side of US 41 and continues north and then northeast away from US 41 at Old US 41A.

### **2.2.5 Verizon Florida, LLC**

Verizon Florida, LLC has indicated there are facilities located on both the west and east side of US 41 and crossing US 41. Existing facilities consist of buried fiber optic cable (foc), overhead telephone cable (ot), buried telephone cable (bt), 4 conduits, 6 conduits, 12 conduits, 16 conduits, and manholes (mh).

### **2.2.6 Hillsborough County Traffic Service Unit**

Hillsborough County Traffic Service Unit has facilities consisting of empty conduit on US 41, west side of roadway, from Symmes Road south to 19<sup>th</sup> Street; street lights from Symmes Road to Riverview Drive; and signals and equipment on US 41 at the intersections of Symmes Road, Palm Avenue, Gibsonton Drive, Riverview Drive, Madison Avenue, and Port Sutton Road.

### **2.2.7 Hillsborough County Water Resource Services**

Hillsborough County Water Resource Services has water main facilities from the south end of the project, to Riverview Drive; sizes range from 1" to 18". There is an 8" C-900 pvc sanitary force main from north of Ohio Street to Symmes Road, east side of roadway.

Hillsborough County Water Resource Services has advised that there are asbestos concrete pipes in the area. These materials may create a hazardous material work area if encountered. The known pipe locations are labeled on the Preliminary Conceptual Design Plans (Ex: "18" ACP water main").

### **2.2.8 Level 3 Communications**

Level 3 Communications has facilities along the entire project area; there are HDPE (12 count) Duct Bank Casings on the east side of the roadway. Depth of facilities varies (40"-60") and bore under cross streets (100"). Occupation by easement is indicated.

### **2.2.9 TECO Peoples Gas Tampa**

TECO Peoples Gas has facilities starting at the intersection of US 41 and Old US 41 on east side of the roadway, and running north through the end of project area. There are several gas mains that cross US 41 at various locations, and there are high pressure facilities that crosses US 41 near the intersection of US 41 and Madison Ave.

The purple-light blue lines around Madison Avenue are extremely high gas pressure-cannot relocate easily, red one's around 125#'s psig, orange (if any-10#'s psig) , again diameter varies (2"-6").

### **2.2.10 TECO Peoples Gas Transmission**

See responses above.

### **2.2.11 City of Tampa Water**

City of Tampa Water has indicated presence of facilities consisting of the types listed below, beginning at Old US 41 and US 41 and lying at various locations on both sides of roadway north to end of project area and continuing north: 1" Galv water main (wm), 2" CI wm, 6" CI wm, 8" CI wm, 8" DIP wm, 12" CI wm, 12" DIP wm, 16" DIP wm, 24" CI wm, 24" DIP wm.

### **2.2.12 Tampa Bay Pipeline Corporation**

Tampa Bay Pipeline operates 4" and 6" Ammonia pipelines in Hillsborough and Polk Counties. Through the limits of the project, they have two 4 inch lines servicing Mosaic's Riverview Plant and TECO's Big Bend Plant. These two lines run along the west side of US 41 from Port Sutton Rd. to Riverview Drive and Port Sutton Rd to Pembroke Rd.

### **2.2.13 City of Tampa Sewer**

City of Tampa Sewer has indicated no facilities in project area.

### **2.2.14 Tampa Electric Company**

Tampa Electric Company has indicated they have 13.2 kv power lines the entire length of the project area.

### **2.2.15 TECO Fiber**

Tampa Electric Company has indicated they have aerial fiber optic the entire length of the project area.

### **2.2.16 Tampa Port Authority**

Tampa Port Authority has indicated no facilities in project area.

### **2.2.17 Yara North America**

Yara North America did not respond.

### **SECTION 3 UTILITY RELOCATION COST ESTIMATE**

Depending on the location and depth of the utilities, construction of the proposed project will likely require adjustments or relocation of some facilities. Cost for utility adjustments are not included in the total estimated project costs since they will be incurred by the utility owners in many cases. Determination of any utility relocation reimbursement costs will be made by FDOT's legal department during the future design phase.

It should be noted that several utilities are currently located under the existing pavement and would also be under the proposed improvements. The relocation costs could be reduced significantly if these utilities were permitted to remain within the travel way. Approval would need to come from both the utility owners and the FDOT.

Impacts to existing utility facilities can also be reduced or eliminated if Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) is performed during the design phase at potential conflict locations (drainage facilities, traffic signals).

Hillsborough County Water Resource Services has stated the following concerning their facilities (Asbestos Concrete Pipe - ACP): "Public Utilities is responsible for all cost relating to FDOT projects.... we will be taking advantage of the project for replacing the ac pipe as part of the project but.. it will not be reimbursable by FDOT. Our facility is not in an easement so we do not have compensable interest. It is impossible to have a good estimate because it is unknown when the project will go to construction. A preliminary guess is \$3 million". They will be replacing the facility with a 20" DIP transmission line as part of the project. Currently, Port Redwing is replacing some of the AC water line as part of their off-site road improvement.

## **SECTION 4 MITIGATIVE RECOMMENDATIONS**

TECO Peoples Gas has advised that there are high pressure gas mains around the US 41 and Madison Avenue intersection. These facilities would be difficult and costly to relocate and may be impacted by the proposed US 41 project. Coordination with utility owners during the design phase would help alleviate possible excessive costs.

Hillsborough County Water Resource Services has advised that there are asbestos concrete pipes in the project area. These materials may create a hazardous material work area and disposal of hazardous materials, if encountered. Utility coordination during the design phase should be done to identify all asbestos concrete pipe locations and therefore help address all environment and safety regulations during construction. Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) should also be performed during the design phase to confirm and locate the asbestos concrete pipes (ACP).
