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











US 41 AT THE ALAFIA RIVER





EXISTING BRIDGES (LOOKING NORTH)




PROPOSED BRIDGE AT ALAFIA RIVER (DESIGN SPEED = 45 MPH)

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


US 41 AT BULLFROG CREEK

PROPOSED BRIDGE AT BULLFROG CREEK (DESIGN SPEED = 50 MPH)



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
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




PROPOSED SUBURBAN TYPICAL SECTIONS (DESIGN SPEED = 50 MPH)




BETWEEN ALAFIA RIVER BRIDGE AND DENVER STREET (NEAR THE NORTH END OF THE PROJECT)












PROPOSED TYPICAL SECTION NORTH OF ALAFIA RIVER BRIDGE


NORTH APPROACH TO THE BRIDGE, LOOKING NORTH ALONG US 41

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




PROPOSED URBAN TYPICAL SECTIONS (DESIGN SPEED = 45 MPH)


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GRAPHICAL COMPARISON OF EXISTING AND FUTURE ANNUAL AVERAGE DAILY TRAFFIC






