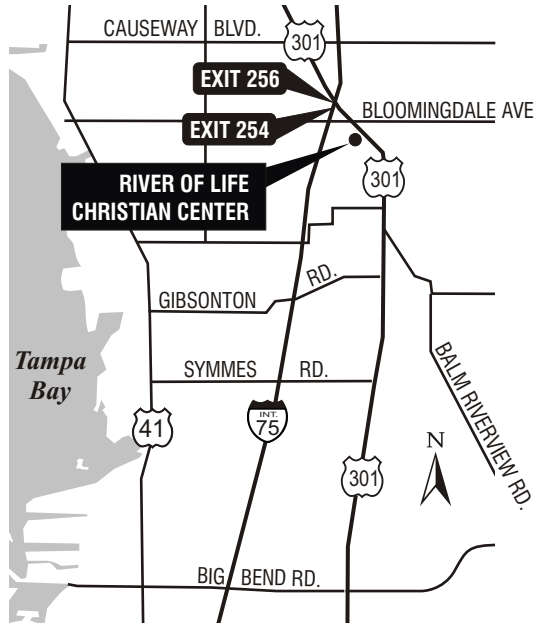

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Studies for two adjacent segments of I-75. The combined limits of both studies extend from Moccasin Wallow Road in Manatee County to north of Fletcher Avenue in Hillsborough County. The PD&E Studies will evaluate transportation demands and needs for improvements up to a design horizon of 2035.



In conjunction with the PD&E Studies, the FDOT is conducting a workshop to discuss the Vision for the I-75 corridor and to receive comments from invited stakeholders. The I-75 Vision will ensure we account for our ultimate needs to at least 2050 and will guide future transportation decision-making. This process will likely influence the future of the corridor's multimodal transportation system.

This workshop is open to the public. However, active participation is limited to invitees only. This workshop is being held in advance of the alternatives public workshops for the PD&E Studies which are anticipated to be held in Spring 2009.
